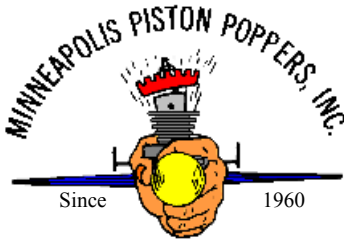

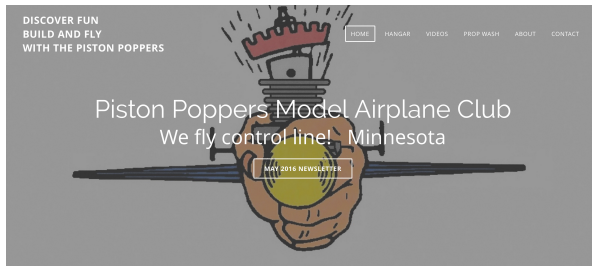

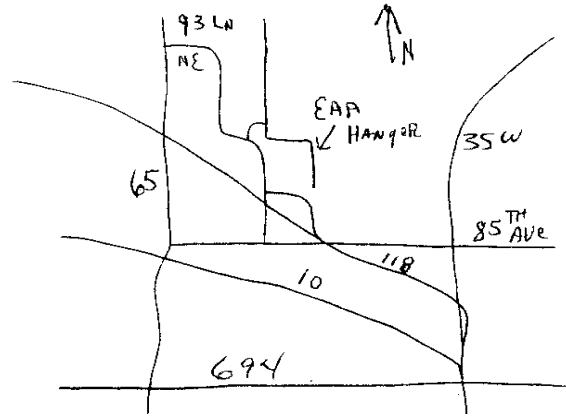
I thanked Tom for all the effort he and Jerry have done to reduce the
