April Meeting

Old Business: The February swap meet netted about \$250 for the club by selling items from George Muellerleile and others.

New Business: The club wants to have a memorial picnic in honor of members who have passed in the last few years. It was decided to have it on Saturday June 4th. It will be at the airport field with something like hot dogs and hamburgers and other snacks. Members are welcome to bring other snacks and refreshments if they like. Bob Cheney will try and contact the family members to invite them and let them know about the picnic.

Tony asked me about the rules letting other non-club members fly at our field. This is from our set of rules we sent to the FBO and agreed to: 1. Everyone flying at the airport must be a Piston Poppers member, or an AMA member or under the direct supervision of a MPP club member.

Tony heard that there will be some kind of a one day D.A.D. on June 11th. He didn't know where it may be, either at the EAA south end or at the Lynx FBO, (now Atlantic FBO). I was able to find this info from the EAA website about it just today on May 30th. "Fly-in Event at the Atlantic FBO June 11th from 10am to 2pm EAA Chapter 237 will be serving 1/3lb burgers, brats, 1/4lb hot dogs and chicken sandwiches. Proceeds benefit the EAA Young Eagles flights and other educational programs".

This sounds like just a fly-in/lunch that the public is invited to attend.

There is no other info about any displays or other activities during that day. If that changes, I'll let you know, but I wouldn't expect anything like in the past years. Of course since we're already insured for the airport we can fly all that day at our field. I would encourage we practice all safety procedures that the AMA recommends.

The concrete circle has been approved for the airport field. It was suggested that we might try pavers instead of pouring concrete. There has already been a Porta-Potty at the school field in the past few years and we haven't needed to rent one ourselves, we'll see what happens there this summer. Glen Peterson sent in our State nonprofit paperwork. I of course sent our check to the AMA for the Club Charter and insurance, we're covered until March 31 2023.
