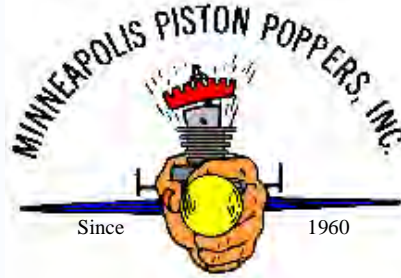

This is my Electric P-51D Mustang from Eric Rule's RSM Distribution. It has a 36" wingspan. 291 square inches. Price was \$179.95 with electric flip and fly motor kit.

RSM 15 Electric Power System equal to .15 Glow Power. Includes RSM Black Tiger BK3530C Motor, 30 Amp Speed Controller, KR Timer/Sequencer, 2200 mAh 3 cell Battery & 9x6 PusherProp. Comes with all programming installed. This power system is ready to be installed in your model. Just flip the switch and fly!

OFFICIAL FLIGHTS WILL BEGIN AT 9 AM.

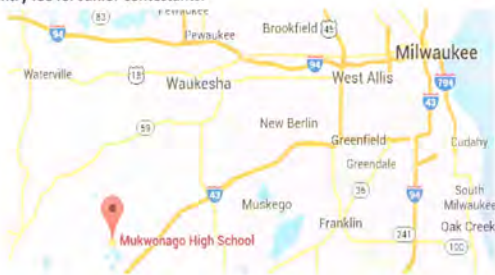
